## **Butte County Farm Bureau Endorses Kirk for Re-Election**

*(Oroville, CA)* – The Butte County Farm Bureau has announced their endorsement of Supervisor Maureen Kirk in her bid for re-election in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Supervisorial District.

She understands the challenges farmers face and she will continue to work to ensure future generations have the same opportunity to farm our rich soil,” said Rocky Donati president of the Butte County Farm Bureau.
